We invite you to study at National Aviation University, to join over 23,000 students who have already become part of it, with 1,352 foreign nationals from 55 countries among them.

The list of specialties offered covers practically all branches of education, both aviation-related and those in the other fields. The university trains future pilots, unmanned aerial vehicle operators, ground-handling aircraft technicians and aviation engineers, air traffic controllers and engineers, aircraft equipment, avionics and radio electronics specialists, designers of modern airports, buildings and roads, airport service professionals, managers in aviation transportation and logistics, specialists in cyber defense and system diagnostics, environmentalists, economists, lawyers, psychologists, physicians, and specialists in other areas. Our university has the world's only educational hangar, a training aerodrome, and a ground service equipment ground, simulator facilities, a training and scientific aerodynamic complex based on the TAD-2 subsonic aerodynamic tube.

The main competitive advantage of our university in the world educational market is the aviation component. Most foreign students primarily choose aviation-related specialties. The retraining and advanced training of civil aviation leaders is also a key to the perception of the university as a worldrenowned aviation educational center.

WELCOME to NATIONAL AVIATION UNIVERSITY

Among our achievements is the creation of a NAU-based International Pilot Training Center for civil aviation of Ukraine and the EU. We plan to invest in the acquisition of the necessary equipment, in particular, of two FNTPII-class flight simulators, eight K-10 aircraft, four Cessna 172 planes, eight Tecnam P2008 aircraft, four Tecnam P2006 aircraft. We also plan to reconstruct and upgrade the existing four L410 UVP-E planes, overhaul an artificial runway equipped with the light-signal system at the aerodrome of NAU Flight Academy in Kropyvnytsky. The Center should fully cover the demand of air carriers from Ukraine, partly of those from the EU, Africa, and Middle East in highly skilled pilots.

At the Aviation University Forum held on the sidelines of the ICAO Second World Summit, we signed the Agreement on the Establishment of the International Association of Aviation and Aerospace Education (ALICANTO). Together with NAU, the agreement was signed by representatives of the leading aviation universities from Australia, Belarus, the United Kingdom, Venezuela, Georgia, Germany, Italy, Canada, China, South Korea, South Africa, Poland, Russia, Romania, Singapore, Slovakia, the USA, Turkey, France, and Czech Republic.

For the first time, our university represents Ukraine in ICAO's governing and expert bodies: Professor Galina Suslova has been elected for a two-year term Chair of the Board of Directors of the European / North Atlantic Aviation Security Training Center, while Professor Oleksandr Zaporozhets became member of the ICAO Committee on Aviation Environmental Protection.

In the next 20 years, global civil aviation will require around half a million pilots, 100,000 air traffic controllers, one million cabin crew and more than half a million technical personnel for aircraft maintenance. National Aviation University is actively expanding its segment in the international education market. The NAU diploma has been and remains a calling card of quality and professionalism, and is recognized as competitive in many countries.

he name of the ICAO NAU Training Institute is linked to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), which was established in 1944 to ensure the effective development of the global air transportation system and to develop the basics of aviation safety regulation.

Taking into account the high international authority of National Aviation University, in 1996, the European Regional Training Center for Aviation Safety was opened at the University. The positive experience gained by the Center was the basis for the opening in 2002 at the University of the European Regional Training Center for the Training of ICAO State Aircraft Safety and Airworthiness Inspectors. Subsequently, national centers operating under the ICAO methodology were opened. Training at the centers is conducted in certified English and Russian, both official languages of ICAO.

To ensure coordination of the training of aviation safety professionals, in 2003, National Aviation University created ICAO Training Institute. Professor, ICAO expert Galina Suslova has been appointed director of ICAO NAU Training Institute.

2003, nearly 19.000 Since of various employees aviation administrations, aviation enterprises, airports, aviation enterprises, air clubs, aviation-related educational and institutions from Ukraine and 77 other countries have been trained and retrained in ICAO Institute's educational centers. In 2018, more than 1,400 aviation professionals from 34 countries were awarded International Certificates.


