

# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## FOUR STEPS

### STEP ONE.

#### *Get Invite to study*

**To get an invitation for study** it is necessary to apply to the University administration by e-mail [post-fsf@nau.edu.ua](mailto:post-fsf@nau.edu.ua) with the request to admit you for study at the National Aviation University.

Next will be the most convenient means of communication [e-mail](#).

**The following documents have to be sent at the NAU:**

- [application form](#)
- **consent to personal data collection and processing**
- **copy of the first page of the passport** (full name, citizenship, date of birth, No. of passport, place of permanent residence)
- **copy of secondary school certificate including list of courses and grades received**

Admission fee is 1578 UAH.

The cost of visa support is 324 UAH.

**Invitation for study necessary for:**

- obtaining visas to enter Ukraine
- justifying the purpose of entry at passport control (border guards checked)
- admission to university

### STEP TWO.

#### *Get a long-term visa (type D)*

**To get an entry visa to Ukraine** you should apply to the Embassy of Ukraine in your or neighbouring country with the application for issue of an entry visa and the NAU invitation for study.

### STEP THREE.

#### *Tell us the date and time of arrival*

At the international airport Boryspil/Kyiv (Kyiv) you will be met by the University representative and be transferred to the University campus.

### STEP FOUR.

#### *Become a student of NAU*

**Not later than the day after arrival** submit documents required for admission to the Directorate of International Education Center IICE and pass the introductory interview.

**Documents Required for Admission**

- **passport with visa** to enter Ukraine
- **certificate of completed secondary education** with list of subjects and grades
- **8 photos** 4x6 cm

All documents should be approved in accordance with the legislation of the country issued them, translated into Ukrainian and legalized.

**FOREIGN STUDENTS EDUCATION PREPARATORY DEPARTMENT**

Foreigners who do not speak the language of study are admitted to the Preparatory Department for the period of one year where training is carried out on the following directions: Engineering or Medicine. Foreigners study the Ukrainian languages, History of Ukraine, Geography, Mathematics, Physics, Computer science, Biology depending upon the chosen direction.
