

ARTICLES SUBMITTED FOR THE PUBLICATION SHOULD MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

The materials are submitted in the format of Microsoft Word 97-2007 for Windows, Times New Roman, single line space. An article size up to 6 pages of A4 (210 x 297), margins all around 20 mm
Reports will be not edited before publishing. Authors are responsible for the content of the report.

Requirements to the text outline:

Font 12, center-aligned,
space from below 6 pt

TITLE OF THE ARTICLE

Authors Name/s

Font 12, bold, all letters capital, center-aligned, space from below – 12 pt,
without hyphenation.

The title must be as short as possible
and to characterize precisely and briefly
the area of submission

Department name of organisation (font 11, center-aligned)
City, Country (font 11, center-aligned, space from below – 12 pt.)

Requirements to the abstract: font 11, italic, left-aligned without the first line indent, space from left and right 10 mm, space from below – 6 pt, the text should not be longer than 120 words.

Keywords: font 11, italic, left-aligned without the first line indent, space from left and right 10 mm, space from below – 12 pt.

Font 12, bold, center-aligned,
space from below 6 pt.

Level 1 Heading

Examples of this Heading Level are **Introduction, Method, Results, Discussions and Conclusions, Acknowledgments, References**

Level 2 Heading. The text of the article – font 12, first line indent of the paragraph is 10 mm, the text must be justified. Space from below 6 pt.

Numbering of the tables – in the order in which they are first mentioned in text, with Arabic numerals, right-alignment. Title of the table must be centered.

Font 10, space from below 6 pt

Font 10, italic, space from
below 6 pt

References in text should be within brackets [1]. Figure captions should be below the figures, font 11, centered, space from below 12 pt.




Figure 1. Example of a figure caption.

For formulas it is recommended to use build-in Word for Windows Equation Editor using the following styles: Text, Function, Variable, Number Times New Roman; L.C.Greek, U.C.Greek, Symbol Symbol; Matrix/Vector Times New Roman, bold. It is recommended to use such font sizes: Full- 12 pt, Subscript/Superscript – 7 pt, Symbol – 18 pt, Sub-Symbol 12 pt.

Acknowledgments (Level 1 Heading)

Identify grants or other financial support for the study. Acknowledge colleagues who assisted in conducting the study or critiquing the paper. Disclose any special circumstances such as the paper being based on an earlier study, a doctoral dissertation, or variation of related research. If any relationships may be perceived as a conflict of interest, explain them here. Also include any required disclaimer such as stating that the views of the research reported does not reflect the views of the employers or granting organization.

For presentation purposes should be submitted brief information about the author (authors), such as position, work experience, professional interests, achievements, links to publications etc. (in the separate file Microsoft Word 97-2007).
