Under the influence of globalization, current international legal relations are changing their structure, losing their inherent permanent characteristics. These circumstances necessitate the training of highly qualified and competitive specialists in international law in the national and international labor markets. This is the task of the educational and professional program developed by the working group of the Department of International Law and Comparative Law of the Faculty of International Relations of the National Aviation University, which has many years of experience, strong teaching potential and modern material and technical base.


The peer-reviewed educational and professional program "International Law" for the preparation of applicants for the second (master's) level of higher education in the specialty 293 "International Law" at the National Aviation University was developed after consultations with scientists and potential employers who confirmed the need for training specialists in this specialty.

The peer-reviewed educational and professional program defines general and professional competencies, presents the scope and description of the educational program, provides the normative content of training of higher education students, formulated in terms of learning outcomes, defines the form of certification of students and requirements for the system of internal quality assurance of higher education. The curriculum for the master's degree program "International Law" fully meets the goals and objectives of the educational and professional program.

The sequence of studying disciplines, the plan and schedule of the educational process, the list and scope of normative and elective educational components fully comply with the structural and logical scheme of training of higher education students in the specialty 293 "International Law" and are designed to help ensure that the program learning outcomes meet the needs of potential employers.

The analysis of the document submitted for review allows us to conclude that the educational and professional program "International Law" meets the European and world requirements for the training of specialists of the second (master's) level of higher education in the specialty 293 "International Law".

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
